

AFTER APPLICATION PROCESS – STUDENT EXCHANGE

Thank you for submitting your application to UWA’s exchange program. Here’s what happens, now:

1. **Assessment of your UWA application** - Check your student email account! If we require further information, we will contact you over the break.
2. **Outcome of application** - The Student Exchange Selection Committee will meet in February and July. The outcome of your application will be released towards the end of February or July.
3. **Selection to Participate in the UWA Exchange Program** – applicants will be selected on the following eligibility criteria:
 - a. **A Weighted Average Mark of 65** – applications from students with WAMs of 63.5 and higher will be considered on a case by case basis.
 - b. **36 points completed at UWA** – advanced standing credit is included.
 - c. **Sufficient points remaining to carry the exchange** – 24 points for a 1-semester exchange, 48 points for a 2-semester exchange. Applicants for exchange in their final semester, who will only have 18 points remaining, will be considered on a case by case basis.

Applicants who do not meet these criteria will not be considered.

4. **Host University Allocation** – Host university allocations are based on WAM. Due to limited available places at our exchange partner universities, allocation to any of your preferences cannot be guaranteed. Please note that *all* of our partner universities have a finite number of exchange places. If we are unable to allocate you to any of your six preferences, we will contact you and ask you to provide further preferences and study plans.

Things that you can do while waiting for your application outcome:

- **Update your contact details in StudentConnect.**
- **Apply for a passport or renew your old passport. Your passport will need to be valid for six months after your return to Australia, after exchange.**
- **Create a budget and start saving.**
- **DO NOT BOOK TRAVEL** – exchange students must follow a special travel booking process which cannot be completed until you have host university acceptance.
- **Enjoy the break!**
